Venue

[Lake Eustis Sailing Club](#) is located about 40 miles north of Orlando in Eustis at 1310 CR 452, Eustis, Florida 32726

Classes Expected

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in **The Racing Rules of Sailing**. 10 or more pre-registered boats in a class are required for a class division with a separate start. Any class with less than 5 entries will race in the Portsmouth class. Classes expected are Flying Scot (Florida Point Series Regatta), Wayfarer, C-Scows, A-cats, Flying Dutchman, Lightning, Viper 640, San Juan 21, Laser, Laser Radial, Laser 4.7, Opti, C420 and a Portsmouth Class.

Eligible participants may enter by completing an entry form, registering with the organization authority and paying the entry fee. Open fleet boats must be 21 ft or under.

Boat registration and meals

Registration

- Adults (over 17): \$55.00 on or before Jan 31, 2010, \$75 after Jan 31, 2010
- Juniors (under 18): \$25.00 on or before Jan 31 2010, \$35.00 after Jan 31, 2010
- There will be box lunches available both Sat. and Sun. for \$7.00 each.
- There is an after race meal on Sat. that is free for skippers and crew. \$5.00 for guests.

Scoring

USSA Appendix A using the Low-Point scoring system with no discards. This changes RRS A2. Five races are scheduled. A minimum of one race must be completed to constitute a regatta. Handicap computations will be made using the Portsmouth Handicap system as published by US SAILING.

Trophies

Number of trophies depends on number of pre-registered boats and classes received by February 1, 2008. There will be 3 trophies for 5 boats, 4 for 9 boats, and 5 for 15 or more boats. The Laser Fleet (Adult and Junior Divisions) will compete for the Florida Lakes Laser Championship Perpetual Trophy. The Flying Scots (Men and Women Divisions) will compete for the Lake Eustis Flying Scot Challenge Perpetual Trophy

Lodging

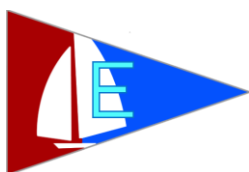
